Minutes of the A.P. 4th State Conference held on 24.11.2013 at UTF Bhavan, Hyderabad.

Dear friends,

The A.P. State Conference of AINVSA was organised on 24-11-2013(Sunday) at UTF Bhavan, Domalguda, Hyderabad. It was attended by 70 delegates from 21 Vidyalayas across the state. The meeting was presided over by Shri K.B.V.D.P.Sharma, President, AINVSA (AP SEC). **Shri. L.B.Reddy**, General Secretary, CEC, AINVSA was the **Chief Guest** and **Shri. A.K. Basawaraj**, General Secretary, SEC, Karnataka was the **guest of honour**. At the outset **Shri K.K.Tilak**, welcomed the delegates. On his request, Shri L.B.Reddy, General Secretary, AINVSA **CEC** appraised the delegates about the post strike developments. He also briefed the delegates about the pension case in detail. The following were some of the salient points from his speech.

1. **A** cabinet note was prepared in connection with the granting of CCS Pension to the staff and it is under circulation among the Central Govt Ministries and Departments.
2. The pension case hearing will be on 21st January 2014.
3. The Association should send a delegation to Delhi during the Parliament session to expedite the matter by seeking the support of Hon'ble MPs.
4. There is still an urgent need to strengthen the Association at grass root level as any Association cannot fulfil the aspirations of its members and lead the struggle without strong Vidyalaya units. The leaders at the top brass cannot lead the struggle with weaker units at the Vidyalaya level.
5. The participants were explained of the problems in conducting the National Conference in Delhi. They were appealed to lend financial support. It was felt that the Association would not get media attention in the present political scenario if the proposed National Conference was organised in Delhi in February. Besides the financial constrains may come in the way.

Smt.K.Manjula, General Secretary, AP SEC, has presented a detailed report on the activities of state committee. In her report she opined that, a strong organisation is only the path for achieving the long pending demands of staff. She urged the delegates to be united and requested them to strengthen the organisation.

The following resolutions were adopted unanimously in the conference:

1. It was agreed to send a delegation to Delhi on 7th December 2013 to meet the Hon'ble MPs and Central Ministers to seek their support to get pension for the staff and recognition for the Association.
2. It was resolved to extend a financial support of **Rs.5000** especially to meet the expenditure for the Delhi delegation and it was also requested to clear the expenses incurred by the Association during the strike period. The list of schools from where no contributions were received will be displayed on the website with a request to collect the amount from the members at the earliest.
3. It was also resolved to make audio/video bites for **CNN IBN** channel to prepare news stories on the several JNVs. The JNVs of Prakasam I, Khammam I, Medak, Mahabubnagar and Visakhapatnam will send the bites to the CEC which will be handed over them to the **CNN IBN** news channel.
4. It was proposed to host the 6th National Conference in Hyderabad in February 2014.
5. **It was also resolved that each JNV from AP would mobilize Rs 1,00,000 as voluntary contributions from educational institutions, corporate, philanthropists, JNV alumni, contractors, real estate ,etc.**

The pre-lunch session was concluded by Shri.K. Matta Reddy, PGT History (JNV, East Godavari) who gave an account of his unit's efforts to meet Shri Pallam Raju through various channels and requesting him for the granting of CCS Pension to the employees. His unit's efforts were appreciated by the delegates.

The post-lunch session began with the address of Shri.N. Narayana, Honorary President UTF and Vice-President of STFI (School Teachers Federation of India). He enlightened the participants of the changing trends in education, government policies and they were threatening the existence and sustenance of the government schools. He welcomed Association's decision to join hands with STFI and promised to lend their support in the resolution of our just and long-pending demands. Shri. P.Manik Reddy, Treasurer, APUTF also addressed the gathering and suggested ways of strengthening the Association to meet the grievances of the staff.

The conference has unanimously elected following state executive committee.
