Dear friends,

You are aware that AINVSA has called for a Dharna at headquarters on 22.04.2015. In this connection the Central Executive Committee would like to bring to your notice the factors that lead the Association to plan this programme.

**1. Strike:** We went on indefinite strike for 10 days in February 2013 and called it off on the assurances given by the Ministry to resolve our problems in a time bound manner. Smt. Vrinda Sarup, who was then the Additional Secretary, Dept. School Education & Literacy, Govt. of India, instructed NVS to have regular meetings with the associations and sort out the problems. But NVS turned a deaf ear to her suggestions.

**2. Undemocratic attitude of NVS:** Following the nationwide strike, NVS appointed a few committees to study certain problems and find out remedies. But there were no nominees in the committees from AINVSA. NVS went ahead to deal with the issues as it liked. The Committees put forward before NVS certain suggestions after some deliberations. But they have not been conveyed to the staff and no action has been taken on them. In the last two years NVS has never invited/involved associations to discuss the pending problems. Doesn't this speak enough of Samiti's respect for democracy and its concern for the staff?

**3. Initiation of adoption of CCS (RSA) Rules 1993:** The Commissioner announced the initiation of the exercise for the recognition of service associations on 19-02-2014. There are no time bound activities in this exercise and no involvement of the associations that have been demanding for recognition. No clear cut instructions have been given regarding the deduction of subscriptions from the members. The CCS (RSA) Rules 1993 have been misread and misinterpreted by some ROs. The schools have not been given instructions to remit the subscriptions in the account of the associations.

**4. Appeals:** AINVSA has written to NVS again and again requesting it to involve the associations and wind up the exercise. Till date the Association has not received a single rupee as subscription from the schools.

**5. Efforts of AINVSA:** A delegation of AINVSA comprising of representatives from A.P, Telangana, UP, Haryana, Maharashtra and Rajasthan met the union Ministers and the M.Ps of the ruling and the opposition parties between 09-03-2015 and 14-03-2015 and sought their intervention in the recognition matter. It also met the Secretary, Department of school education and literacy on 11.03.2015, the Commissioner on 12-03-2015 and HRM on 16.03.2015. But there was no categorical assurance. It is evident that NVS has decided to drag its feet on the recognition issue as long as it pleased. It doesn't want the association's to influence its decisions. It is bent on continuing its unilateral role as long as it wills.

**6. Indifferent attitude of NVS:-**Condemning the indifferent attitude of NVS the CEC decided to call for a mass Dharna in front of the headquarters on 22.04.2015. It invites your huge participation. Without agitations and sacrifices we cannot build a strong movement. It is once again time to make the deaf NVS hear our pleas and address them honestly. It is once again time to make it understand that it cannot realize its objectives without addressing our problems sincerely.

**7. Appeal to Units:-**The CEC, AINVSA, appeals to you once again to meet your local MPs and present them a memorandum demanding recognition to our Association. An action plan has been prepared by the Association in connection with the Dharna on 22<sup>nd</sup> April and it can be downloaded from [www.ainvsa.com](http://www.ainvsa.com). Time is very short. Follow the action plan, nominate representatives from your vidyalaya, support them financially to attend the dharna and extend them the logistic support. The summer parliament session is beginning from 20-04-2015 and it is the right time to seek the support of the political parties, MPs and draw the attention of the government of India. Remember that your action breathes life into the Association and your inaction can lead us to the tyrannical days of 1990s.

Long live AINVSA!
