**Dear Friends**

We are trying to get information from the **NVS** regarding the academic and non-academic classification of our duties through RTI. It is very likely that **NVS** might call many of the non-academic duties like **MOD**, House Master and **JNVST** duties as academic. But before we get their reply, we think it is better to garner more support to our claim that the duties mentioned in the second format (the formats are enclosed herewith) are non-academic and the teachers should not be burdened with un-constitutional work (Kindly go through the 24 and 27 provisions of the **Right to Education Act - 2009**, which is a simple format).

We also want you to understand that since the duties are non-academic, NVS has no right to burden the **teachers** by contending that the teachers are granted HM Honorarium and **10% Special Allowance**. Every teacher working in JNVs knows how challenging the non-academic work has become over the years and how it is a hindrance to their efforts to offer better academic services to the students. We all have joined the organization as teachers, not as multi-task teachers. Our prime and secondary duties should always be academic. It is unjustifiable to compel us to do non-academic work by engaging us extra hours and depriving us of our valuable personal time. Let us demand the **NVS** to honour the constitution and our constitutional right against the imposition of the non-academic duties.

We believe that the teaching staff in your JNV will participate in a healthy and thorough debate on the queries and duties mentioned in the formats and hope you will e-mail your scanned feedback forms.
