Sub:-Requirement of funds for Pension case in Supreme Court regarding.

It's no secret that **AINVSA** supported the pension case filed by Shri P.N. Mishra, retired O.S, at Ranchi High Court from the beginning till the end. Huge funds were collected to run the case by the Ranchi Vidyalaya unilaterally without any formal approval of the CEC. The anxiety for pension the signals of a positive verdict spread through the emails of your vidyalaya during the last stages of the case encouraged thousands of teaching and non-teaching employees to contribute their hard-earned money to support the case.

Unfortunately, the case was lost. But the lakhs of rupees that have accumulated in your account have turned you bolder instead of making you accountable. Your vidyalaya decided to proceed ahead with Shri Mishra's case instead of allowing the Association to run the case at Supreme Court level. The obvious reason is your vidyalaya doesn't like to be dictated by the Association and decided to enjoy the freedom of spending the huge funds at your will and pleasure. The setting up of a fake association has revealed these intentions clearly. Besides, your vidyalaya has failed to intimate the staff of the details of expenditure incurred by you on regular basis. Thus, your vidyalaya committee which has collected the funds betrayed the trust of thousands of your brethren.

The Association filed the Pension Case at the Apex Court following the decision of CEC in May 2011 in spite of severe shortage of funds. The Association delinked Mr. Mishra's service related issues from the case as his issues might make the Pension demand of thousands of staff only secondary. The Association appealed to you disburse a reasonable portion of the funds that your vidyalaya collected to run the Association's case as it was filed on behalf of all the teaching and non-teaching employees. While your vidyalaya contributed Rs.5, 50,000 to the Principal's Forum to run their case at the Apex Court, you disposed only Rs.1.30, 000 in favour of Shri.Ranjit Sharma advocate, the lawyer engaged by the Association to run the case. It clearly shows how your vidyalaya has yielded to intimidations from power centres rather than trusting in the leadership of the Association that is backed by thousands of teaching and non-teaching staff who also raised the funds that are under your disposal now.

The Association is still short of fund to run the Pension Case and various other cases that are linked with the working conditions and welfare issues of the staff and needs to be supported. Hence, we appeal to your vidyalaya committee once again to dispose Rs.4, 00,000 more to meet the expenses of the Association's litigations with a request to immediately circulate to all the vidyalayas the details of accounts of funds by your vidyalaya.
